Chairman Hirschi called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Present: Commissioners Bennett, Hirschi, and Sypnicki. Lisa Brengan was present as minute-taker.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT:** None

<u>MINUTES:</u> Commissioner Bennett **MOTIONED**: to approve the minutes of the August 16, 2023 regular meetings as presented **SECOND**: Commissioner Sypnicki. **Motion passed unanimously**.

<u>COMMUNICATIONS:</u> Lisa asked commissioners if they would like to attend the Snure seminar the night prior to the conference; all three commissioners wish to attend, Lisa will get them registered.

<u>IAFF REPORT</u>: Chief Rudolph described a couple of MOUs he is working on with the Local. One MOU is ready for adoption & signature. Article 27.1.1 is regarding the cost of healthcare, the current contract states if there is more than a 5% increase in premiums, the member would split the increased amount over 5% in half with the District. For 2024, the increase in healthcare premiums is 6%; the MOU states the District will absorb the full 6% increase in 2024, the MOU will expire 12/31/2024.

Commissioner Bennett **MOTIONED**: to adopt MOU on Article 27.1.1 with IAFF 2394, stating the District will absorb the full 6% increase in health care premiums for 2024. **SECOND**: Commissioner Sypnicki. **Motion passed unanimously.**
