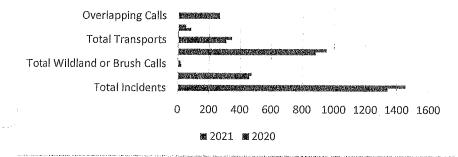
Chief Burbridge:
