CHIEF'S REPORTS:

Chief Report:

- Currently 41 positive COVID cases in Mason County.
- Mason Co. has applied for Phase 3. 4 cases are active with one death.
- ProPhoenix personnel will be at Macecom next week, training and O & A.

Have relaxed the I.C.S.O. position as of yesterday, due to low numbers. Position has been relaxed after Te so monitoring anticipated spike from social gatherings.

Reimbursement up to end of May has been approved. \$144,399.60.

Considering De-mobe Plan for AAC position, should be next BOC meeting.

BOC return to normal meetings on approval of Phase 3?
