MINUTES:

Commissioner Hirschi **MOTIONED**: to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2021 regular meeting **SECOND**: Commissioner Bennett. Unanimous vote. **Motion passes**.

COMMUNICATIONS: Chief Burbridge reported two thank-you notes received; one from District 11 for our participation in the fire at the Port of Shelton and the other from a resident on Teagle. Bloodworks NW is short on blood donations, you may donate if you've had the COVID vaccine, there are rumors that you cannot, so they are in need of donors.

CHIEF'S REPORTS:

Chief Burbridge:

- Lexipol: Initial batch has been sent out for comment. Next (Lexipol) meeting will include the process to push policies out to the membership. Phone app will allow review once there is subject uploaded.
- Station 41 generator: Awaiting Watson's Diesel arrival. Standing by.
- Fleet maintenance: Further discussions with Olympia Fire. Three reports have been completed (By their mechanic) awaiting city approval. OFD's goal is to have approval for one additional FTE in their mechanic shop.
- Without objection of the board, I am relaxing the restriction of state mobilization for the upcoming fire season. PPE has been issued and Capt. Biehl and his crew have placed our brush units in service.


 BOARD AGREED
- Kamilche Point Road wildland fire (4/16): On arrival, clear cut fire 200X200 and spreading. Area homes protected via fireline and helo-operations. Fire district crews and apparatus were hired for the night. No DNR engines in service until next month. Hand crew arrived for assistance. A generous citizen picked up the bill for rehab (Subway.) We are reverse engineering contact for a district coin.
- Walker Park house fire (4/18): Small residential structure, occupants evacuated without injury. Total loss and the cause is under investigation.
- Capt. Walton is moving forward with his fire investigation task book. Currently, investigating multiple fires, and this is compensated through the county chiefs and Mason Co.
